To comply with the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 and other related laws including any amended laws in the future, ("Personal Data Protection Act"), T. S. K. Forging Company Limited ("Company") prepared this Privacy Notice ("Notice") to describe in detail the collection, use and disclosure of personal data. This notice is intended for the Company's visitors entering into the Company's premises for any business with the Company or persons associated with the Company

Definitions

"Personal data"	refers to data relating to a natural person which makes it possible to identify that person	
	directly or indirectly but not including data of the deceased in particular.	
"Sensitive persona	refers to personal data about race, ethnicity, political opinions, religious or philosophical	
data"	beliefs, data concerning a natural person's sex life or sexual orientation, criminal record,	
	health data, disability, trade union data, genetic data, biological data or any other data	
	which may cause discrimination against the personal data subject or may similarly affect	
	the personal data subject as prescribed by the Personal Data Protection Act.	
"Legal basis"	refers to a valid legal basis for processing personal data under the Personal Data	
	Protection Act.	
"Company	refers to persons who come to contact with the Company or persons associated with the	
visitors"	Company at the Company's premises for any purposes, such as messengers, service	
	providers, the Company's contractors, participants in activities organized by the Company,	
	etc.	



Types of personal data the Company collects

The Company will collect your personal data as specified in this Notice, in whole or in part, as necessary for the Company to carry out various purposes stated in this Notice.

Sources of personal data

The Company will collect your personal data from the following direct and indirect sources:

Purposes of collecting personal data

The Company will only collect your personal data for use and/or disclosure under the purposes and by virtue of the legal basis as stated in this Notice. Should the Company need to collect additional personal data or use personal data for purposes other than those stated in this Notice, the Company will notify you of the collection of your personal data and/or notify you of the purpose for collecting your data. The Company will also ask for your consent for the collection, use and disclosure of the new personal data in the event that the Company needs to obtain your consent as required by law under the Personal Data Protection Act.

Consequences of not providing personal data

The Company collects personal data to verify and identify you in accordance with the Company's security measures. In the event that you do not provide personal data to the Company, the Company may decide not to allow you to enter the Company's premises.

Disclosure of personal data and the transmission or transfer of personal data

To achieve the purposes of collecting personal data set forth in this Notice, the Company may, under certain circumstances, be required to disclose your personal data to any person or organization, <u>including but not limited</u> to the following persons or organizations:

- Service providers and agents employed by the Company, such as service providers or security system consultants and employees of such service providers, etc.
- Police officers, courts, arbitrators, attorneys, any persons or agencies involved in judicial proceedings and dispute resolution, or other government agencies under the law, such as the Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health, etc.

Retention period of personal data

The Company will keep your personal data for security purposes and to prevent the spread of infectious diseases for a period not exceeding 3 months from the date of entry into the Company's premises.



However, all or part of the personal data may be retained beyond the period specified above to comply with laws applicable to the situation and to protect the lawful rights of the Company or to dispute allegations against the Company. In such cases, the personal data will be retained for the period necessary to carry out such purposes and/or within the period specified by law.

Your rights to proceed with personal data

You have the following legal rights regarding the processing of your personal data

- Right to withdraw consent: You have the right to withdraw your consent of the collection, use or disclosure of personal data, in whole or in part, for the duration of the Company's retention of that personal data. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of data processing prior to the withdrawal of consent.
- 2. Right to access the data subject: You have the right to request access to and obtain a copy of your personal data including personal data that the Company acquired without your consent.
- 3. **Right to data portability**: You have the right to request that the Company transmits or transfers your personal data to another person or yourself under the terms of law.
- 4. Right to object to the collection, use or disclosure of personal data: You have the right to object to the collection, use or disclosure of the personal data under the terms of the law.
- 5. **Right to erasure**: You have the right to request that the Company delete, destroy or turn personal data into nonpersonally identifiable data under the terms of the law.
- 6. **Right to suspend the use of personal data**: You have the right to ask the Company to suspend the use of personal data in accordance with the terms of the law.
- 7. Right to rectification: You have the right to request that the Company correct inaccurate or incomplete data.
- 8. Right to lodge a complaint: You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Personal Data Protection Committee in the event that the Company, its employees or contractors violate or fail to comply with the Personal Data Protection Act.



When forwarding a request to exercise your rights, notify the Company through a written notice to the contact information provided below. In the event that the Company is unable to proceed with your request, the Company will give a detailed explanation of why it cannot carry out your request.
